

Vancouver April 26<sup>th</sup> 1890

A Special Meeting of the Council was held at 3 P. M. of Saturday the 26<sup>th</sup> day of April for the reading of the Liquor License Bylaw the second time and for its consideration in Committee of the Whole.

Present - His Worship the Mayor and the full Board of Aldermen.

Moved by Ald. Horne seconded by Ald. Costello that the Liquor License Bylaw be now read a second time by title only. Carried.

Moved by Ald. Browning, seconded by Ald. Horne that this Council do now go into Committee of the Whole on the Liquor License Bylaw. Carried.

His Worship nominated Ald. Garden as the Chairman of the Committee, who thereupon took the Chair and asked that the bylaw be read and considered clause by clause.

The Bylaw was then considered clause by clause and the necessary amendments made.

Moved by Ald. Horne that the Committee rise and report the Bylaw complete with amendments.

The Committee rose, His Worship resumed the Chair and the bylaw was reported complete.

Moved by Ald. Carrall seconded by Ald. Bentall, that the bylaw be read a third time on Monday May 5<sup>th</sup> and that it receive one days publication in a daily newspaper prior to that date. Carried.

The Council then adjourned.
