The Council held an adjourned meeting on Thursday May 26th 1892 at 8 P.M.

Present Aldermen Anderson, Common, Collins, Scullor, Hoagman, Alderman Franklin and Gavin
Alderman Common was appointed Chairman
Communications

From the Market Board stating that Professor Ral. had refused to pay for the ^{use of the} Market Hall
Referred to the City, solicitor to take such action as he should deem necessary.

From J. W. Cameron et al asking the Mayor and Council to call a public meeting on Saturday the 28th inst. to discuss the proposed lease of the Market.
Referred to his worship, the Mayor.

From Nelson & Sanson asking the Council to ceil the stalls in the Market Hall.
Referred to the Police Committee

Consideration of By-Laws.

Moved by Alderman Scullor
Seconded by " Gavin.

That the Local Improvement By-Laws be read a 2nd time and that the reading of the title be considered the reading of the whole bill.

Carried

Moved by Alderman Gavin
Seconded by " Franklin.

That the Council go into Committee of the whole for its consideration

Carried

Alderman Gavin was appointed Chairman

The By-Laws was read over clause by clause and reported to Council as complete with amendments

The By-Laws was then read a 3rd time on motion of Alderman Gavin seconded by Alderman Alderman.



The By-law governing and regulating streets and side
walks was again considered in Committee of the
whole and two clauses ^{were} added in reference to veran-
dohs and projections.
It was then finally passed.

Moved by Alderman Odium
Seconded by " Gavin
That the Council go into Committee
of the whole for the consideration of the Free Library
By-law.
Carried.
Alderman Odium was appointed Chairman.

Moved by Alderman Scoullar.
Seconded by " McQuinn
That the By-law be considered six months
hence.
Carried.

The Committee then rose and reported the By-law
as being laid over for six months.

Motions

Seconded by " Odium.
That the Poundkeeper be furnished with
a book of street car tickets.
Carried.
