

Lancaster Feb 24th 1891

A Special meeting of the Council was held on Tuesday February 24th 1891 at 1.30 P.M.

Present: His Worship the Mayor and Aldermen Brighouse, Sculler, Godfrey, Timplton, Brown, Greenwood and Spenner.

The meeting was called for the purpose of considering a telegram which was received from the Mayor of Halifax, calling for assistance for the sufferers by the Springhill disaster; where about 117 lives were lost, and many children left fatherless and many widows mourning. Moved by Alderman Timplton

Seconded by " Brown,
That £500⁰⁰ be telegraphed at once to the sufferers.
