

Vancouver Feb 28<sup>th</sup> 1891

A special meeting of the Council was held on Saturday  
February 28<sup>th</sup> 1891.

Present: His Worship, the Mayor and Aldermen Carroll,  
Godfrey, Scoullar, Simpkinson, Hobson, Brown, Medowell  
and DeLincier.

The object of the meeting was to appoint a Committee  
to go to Victoria to oppose the proposed amendment  
to the Vancouver Water Works Co's Charter.

It was resolved.

That His Worship the Mayor &  
Aldermen Godfrey, Brown, Hobson,  
Scoullar, Carroll, Medowell and Simpkinson with  
power to add to their numbers, be appointed to go to  
Victoria to meet the members of the Legislature with  
a view of having the proposed amendments to the  
Vancouver Water Works Co's Act opposed.
