

Vancouver November 21st 1887

The Council met on Monday November 21st 1887 at 7.30. p. m.

Present His Worship Mayor Mackean, Aldermen Alexander, Beard, Hamilton, Humphries, Lockley, Manning, D. Effenheimer, J. Effenheimer and Sanders.

The minutes of last meeting were read and adopted.

The Board of Works met on Friday
November 18th 1887 and report that
applications have been received
for the position of Overseer for the
Park Road and would recommend
the appointment of W. L. McDonald.

We recommend that
tenders be called for the erection
of a three roomed one story Colledge at
the Public Cemetery for the use of the
Caretaker.

In the matter of the petition
of Edgar, C. Goulding we have in-
structed the City Engineer to com-
plete the sidewalks on Dundas
Street and charge the cost thereof
to the Hardins.

We recommend that
tenders be called for the naming
of the Streets with 4 inch letters two
at each corner painted on wood

or line with white letters on black ground number of signs to be not less than 200.
