Whereas by a By-Law of the

City of Vancouver dated 13<sup>th</sup> October A.D. 1886 and by an Agreement made in pursuance of said By. Law it was enacted and agreed that in consideration of certain privileges granted the City of Vancouver to the Vancouver Wharfage and Storage Co. Limited, the said Company would sell to said City at any date after the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December A.D. 1888 the wharf erected by them at its actual value.

And whereas it is necessary and expedient and in the interests of the City that said wharf should be now purchased or that the right to purchase same should be abandoned.

Therefore be it resolved that a Committee be appointed by this Council to consult with said Company with a view to ascertain upon what terms said wharf and approach can be purchased by the City and report to this Council at its next meeting. Said Committee to consist of Aldermen Horne, Whitham, Oppenheimer, McComell and Brewster. Carried.
