The Council met on Wednesday September 7th 1892.
Present His Worship, the Mayor and Aldermen
Anderson, Collins, Scoullar, Franklin, Odum and
Mills.

The object of the meeting was to consider the granting
of a bonus to the D.C. Iron Works Co. and other
business.

After considerable discussion it was moved

That the D.C. Iron Works Co be granted
a bonus of \$20,000 in 4 per cent debentures in con-
sideration of their rebuilding and operating their
works and agreeing to move off the road bed
of Westminster Avenue produced and paying
the rent of the leased property until such time
as it is required by the City for street pur-
poses after expiration
