Ltd. in answer to the advertisement calling for tenders: That the Council are prepared to place a By-law before the citizens without delay to provide the sum of \$360,000 to purchase the assets (free from encumbrances) of the Vancouver Electric Railway & Light Co. Ltd.,...

Moved in amendment by Alderman McCreaney  
Seconded by Alderman Anderson.  
That the amount be made \$380,000

Amendment lost; motion carried
