The Council met on Friday July 7th 1893 at 8. P. M.

couver Street Railway for a term of years. Should

the Shareholders.

voted on to raise the sum of \$370,000 for the purpose
of purchasing the Street Railway, road, plant, privi-
leges, franchise and all assets of the Vancouver
Electric Railway & Light Co. Ltd. including work
now under contract; providing the Trustees ob-
tain the sanction of the Court in 14 days.

That inasmuch as the understanding
with the Railway & Marine Gazette for a write up of
the City at the time of the Dominion Day celebration
has not been carried out, the appropriation of

450⁰⁰ for that purpose be and is hereby recommended.
