The Council held a Special meeting on Wednesday October 23rd 1895;

In the matter of the sale of land mortgaged by Asaph Castleman to the Trustees of the City Sinking Fund, dated the 4th of August 1892 under power of sale contained in the said mortgage to Arthur, C. Henderson of Philadelphia, Merchant; The Mayor and City Councillors are hereby authorized to sign and affix the seal of the City of Bancours to a conveyance of the lands, described in the said mortgage, deed to Arthur, C. Henderson, under the powers contained in the said mortgage and the Incorporation Act 1886, Amendment - Act 1893 he being the purchaser of the said lands, at public auction
