Vancouver June 10th 1886

Council met in the Council Chambers on Thursday June 10th at 7:30 P.M.

Present His Worship the Mayor presiding Aldermen Balfour, Cordiner, Coldwell, Dunn, Hamilton, Humphries, L.A. Hamilton, E.P. Hamilton and Northcott.

Minutes of last meeting read and adopted.

Report of the Board of Works read.

Moved by Alderman Balfour seconded by Alderman Cordiner that the Report of the Board of Works be adopted as a whole. Carried.

[Motion 30]

Moved by Alderman L.A. Hamilton seconded by Alderman Dunn, that as the Map of the City published by Mr. H.B. Smith meets with the approval of the individual members of the Council therefore the Council endorses the map and authorizes Mr. H.B. Smith to publish it as the official Map of the City under the sanction of the Mayor and Council And that the Clerk be authorized to subscribe for one Copy for the Council Chambers.

Carried

Moved by Alderman L.A. Hamilton seconded by Alderman E.P. Hamilton that the Council go into Committee of the whole on Liquor By-Law. Carried.

Council go into Committee of the Whole with Alderman Dunn as the Chair.

Moved by Alderman L.A. Hamilton seconded by the Mayor that By-Law be known as By-Law No. 5. After the By-Law was read over Clause by Clause and passed the Committee rose to report.

Moved by Alderman Dunn seconded by Alderman Northcott that the By-Law be read a third time and that the reading of the title be taken as the reading of the whole bill. Carried.

Moved by Alderman Dunn seconded by Alderman Northcott that By-Law No 5 be engrossed, signed and sealed by the Mayor and Clerk and a copy send to the British Columbia Gazette for publication. Carried.

The Council then adjourned.
