Vancouver May 9 1891

A special meeting of the Council was held on Saturday May 9<sup>th</sup> 1891 at 2 P.M. for the purpose of considering and finally passing the Works By-Law.

Present: His Worship the Mayor and Aldermen Brighthouse, Scoullar, Godfrey, Templeton, Brown, McDowell and Doering.

The By-Law was read a second time on motion of Alderman Brown seconded by Alderman Brighthouse.

The Council went into Committee of the Whole on motion of Alderman Templeton seconded by Alderman Godfrey.

Alderman Brown was appointed Chairman.

The By-Law was read over clause by clause and reported back to Council as complete with amendments.

The By-Law was then read a third time on motion of Alderman Brown seconded by Alderman Brighthouse and ordered to be signed, sealed and gazetted.

The Council then adjourned.
