

Council considers Street Railway By-Law and Agreements. Street Railway Agreements to terminate on same date in 1918. Double track for Granville Street.

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Vancouver January 31st 1899.

The Council met on Tuesday January 31st 1899 at 4 P.M.

Present His Worship the Mayor and Aldermen and full Board of Aldermen.

Moved by Alderman Bruce,

Seconded by Alderman M^cQueen,

That the Council go into Committee of the Whole to consider Street Railway By-Law and Agreements with the Mayor in the Chair.

Carried.

Granville Street Double Track Agreement read.

Moved by Alderman M^cQueen,

That the double track on Granville Street from Robson St. to Davie Street be constructed under Pender Street Agreement first option of purchase June 1906.

Agreement to be the same as Robson and Pender Streets. General clause to make all Agreements terminate on same date in 1918.

Carried.

Davie Street Agreement was then taken up.

Moved by Alderman Bruce,

That the first option of purchase be June 1905.

Moved in amendment by Alderman M^cPhaiden

That the first option of purchase be 1910.

Amendment lost; motion carried.

Moved by Alderman Bruce,

That the Committee rise and report and ask leave to sit again.

Carried.

The Council then adjourned until Friday at 4 P.M.
