Vancouver April 11<sup>th</sup> 1901.

The Council met on Thursday April 11<sup>th</sup> 1901.

Present Aldermen Grant, Painter, Neelands, Cook, McPhaiden, McGuigan, Wood and Fraser.

Moved by Alderman Cook,

Seconded by Alderman Fraser,

That Alderman McGuigan be appointed Chairman

Carried

The object of the meeting was to discuss the proposed agreement with Stave Lake Power Co.

As the full Board was not present it was

Moved by Alderman Painter

Seconded by Alderman McPhaiden

That the Board stand adjourned until Friday at 8 P.M.

Before the motion was carried Alderman Wood reported the death of M<sup>r</sup> J.C. McLagan, one of the  
Pioneers of the City and proprietor of the Daily World.

He moved, Seconded by Alderman Grant.

That a letter of condolence be sent to his widow and that the Council attend his funeral in a body  
and that a wreath be prepared and forwarded to his residence as a testimony of respect.

Carried.
