The Council met on Thursday April 11th 1901.
 Present: Aldermen Grant, Smith, Kellogg, Coors,
 Melharder, McLaughlin, Wood and Fraser.
 Moved by Alderman Coors,
 Seconded by " Fraser,
 That Alderman McLaughlin be ap-
 pointed Chairman

Carried.

 moved by Alderman Parker
 Seconded by " Melharder,
 That the Board stand adjourned
 until Friday at 8 P.M.

Before the motion was carried Alderman
 Wood reported the death of Mr. J. C. Mahagan, one
 of the Honorees of the City and proprietor of the
 "Daily World."

He moved. Seconded by Alderman Grant,
 That a letter of condolence be sent to
 his widow and that the Council attend his funeral
 in a body and that a wreath be prepared and
 forwarded to his residence as a testimony of re-
 spect.
