A Special meeting of the Council was held on Tuesday May 21st, 1901
Present His Worship the Mayor and Ald. Grant, Painter, Neelands, Cook,
M^cPhaiden, Foreman, MacDonald, Fraser and Wood.

Mr. Hooper presented his report recommending the acceptance of the plans of
“Vigil” for the two Fire Halls and those of “Economy” for the Jail.

After examination of plans submitted it was resolved that Mr. Hooper’s report
be adopted.

The keys were then opened when it was found that Vigil was represented by W.J. Whiteway and Economy by W.T. Dalton.

The Council then adjourned.
