

Discussion about a proposal put forward by J. Buntzen, manager of BC Electric, regarding street railway agreements. Alderman Shaw's illness acknowledged.

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Vancouver Oct. 15th 1900.

The Council met on Monday October 15th 1900 at 10 A.M.

Present His Worship the Mayor and Aldermen Grant, McQueen, Neelands, McPhaiden, Foreman, Barker, Wood and Baxter.

The object of the meeting was to consider the proposal by J. Buntzen, Manager of the B.C. Electric Co for the consolidation of the different Street Railway Agreements.

The Council went into Committee of the Whole for its consideration with Alderman McQueen in the Chair. Mr. Buntzen went fully into his proposition. After discussion it was moved by Alderman Neelands

That in the opinion of the Council it is not deemed advisable to waive the option of purchase contained in the Agreements as proposed in the letter of the 13th July 1900 received from the B.C. Elec Co.
Carried.

The Committee then rose and reported the passage of the above resolution.

Seconded by Alderman McPhaiden.

That the sympathy of the Council be extended to Alderman Shaw in his severe illness and hopes that he may recover speedily.
Carried.
