

Vancouver Oct. 15<sup>th</sup> 1900.

The Council met on Monday October 15<sup>th</sup> 1900 at 10. A. M.

Present: His Worship, the Mayor and Aldermen Grant, MacDerm, McLeod, McPherson, Foreman, Barber, Wood and Dyer.  
The object of the meeting was to consider the proposal by J. Dwyer, Manager of the D. C. Electric Co. for the consolidation of the different Street Railway Agreements.

The Council went into Committee of the whole for its consideration with Alderman MacDerm in the Chair.

Mr. Dwyer went fully into his proposition. After discussion it was moved by Alderman McLeod.

That in the opinion of the Council it is not deemed advisable to waive the option of purchase contained in the Agreements proposed in the letter of the 13<sup>th</sup> July 1900. Received from the D. C. Elec. Co.

The Committee then rose and reported the passage of the above resolution. Carried.
